Downtown Parking and Circulation

The City will hold an open house on Tuesday, January 17, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. in the **Surfsand Ballroom, 148 W. Gower Street**, Cannon Beach (one block west of Hemlock Street on the north side of Gower Street, upper level of the Surfsand Resort lobby).

The City has initiated a design study to determine whether to convert a portion of the existing wastewater treatment lagoons into additional public parking to serve the downtown area. The design study will also examine potential improvements and modifications to pedestrian circulation in the downtown area.

The purpose of the open house is to present conceptual design alternatives with regard to the redevelopment of the wastewater lagoons and enhanced pedestrian circulation in the downtown area. The meeting is an opportunity for the public to provide comment on the design alternatives. Community response to the design alternatives will be used refine those alternative. Refined design alternatives will be presented at a public meeting on Tuesday, February 21, 2006.

Background materials describing the alternatives that will be presented at the open house will be available at City Hall on January 11, 2006.
