

City of Cannon Beach Goals and Objectives 2009-2010

ITEMS FOR ACTION WITHIN ONE YEAR

(The first seven items all relate to Emergency Preparedness)

1. Organize volunteers to go door-to-door during major storms.
2. Continue stocking of prepositioned supplies.
3. Investigate local broadcast station capability.
4. Evaluate portable shelter arrangements.
5. Evaluate permanent shelter in Tolovana area
6. Work with Clatsop County officials to evaluate joint 911.
7. Work with Clatsop County officials to establish Emergency Operation Center in Warrenton area.
8. Continue to evaluate the purchase of property and developing financing plans for the Ecola Watershed expansion.
9. Evaluate commercial recycling.
10. Consolidate recycling facilities to the east end of 2nd Street.
11. Build a new sea wall at the W. 2nd Street beach access
12. Create a public square at the W. 2nd Street beach access.
13. Develop a street lighting master plan for downtown with focus on LED type fixtures.
14. Work with School District to relocate Cannon Beach Elementary School.
15. Work with the Community Action Team to develop work force housing.
16. Evaluate ways to increase funding for the arts.

ITEMS FOR ACTION WITHIN THREE YEARS

17. Develop plan for E. 2nd Street to eventually accommodate additional parking, pedestrian bike trail, wetlands expansion, consolidation of recycling facilities, relocation of yard waste area and relocation of wastewater lab.



18. Secure recently discovered cannons for the community of Cannon Beach.
19. Implement process to evaluate options for the reuse of Cannon Beach Elementary School property.
20. Explore affordable housing options.
21. Investigate fortifying/reconstructing/relocating City Hall.
22. Support implementation of the Sustainability Committee's Action Plan.
23. Develop pedestrian and bike trail.
24. Continue advancing estuarine habitat restoration.
25. Continue to evaluate the purchase of property and developing financing plans for selected city priorities such as relocated public facilities, wind energy, work force housing and open space acquisition, pedestrian and bike trail and senior services center.
