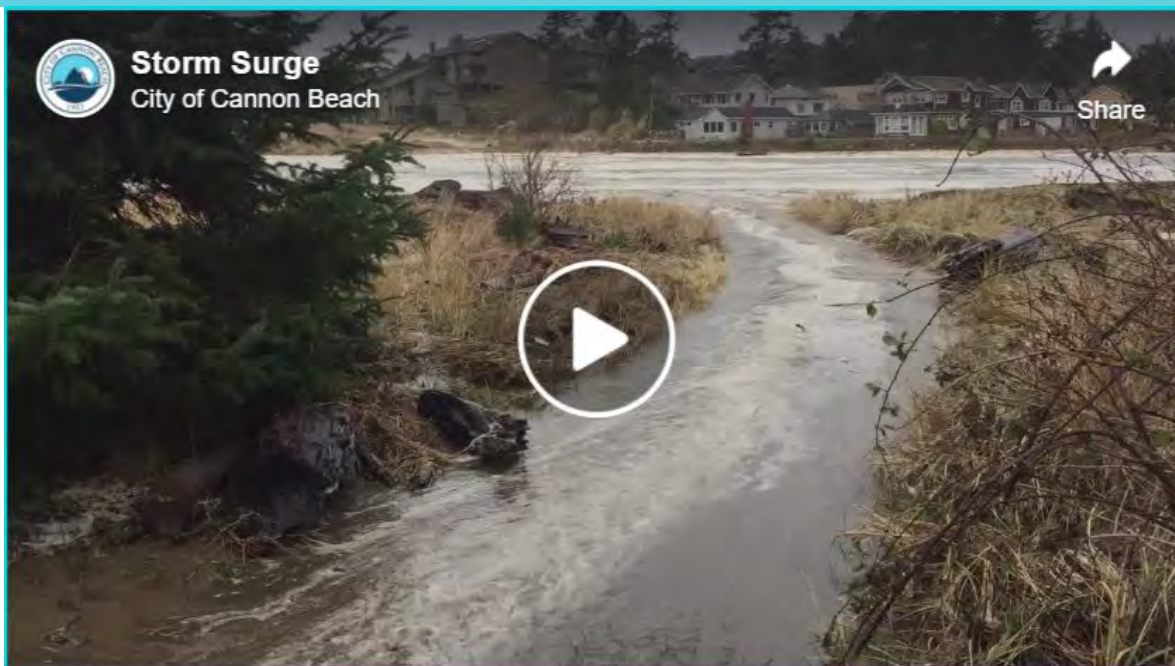

CITY HALL CLOSED TO VISITORS EXCEPT BY APPOINTMENT

Effective **August 27, 2021**, the following policies will be in place per Administrative Order 21-02:

- All City operations will continue with the exception that City Hall will be closed to visitors inside the building. All in-person transactions will take place through the walk-up window installed next to the ballot drop box.
 - The service window will be open daily from 8:00 – 5:00 pm
 - If you need to meet with a staff member, please schedule an appointment with that staff member
 - A predetermined time and location will be set and staff will meet you there, i.e. Council Chambers door at 2pm
 - For non-monetary transactions with the Community Development Department, the drop off/pick up box is still available outside their office
- There will be no audience members for City Council, Commissions, Boards and Committees meeting.
 - All public comment, participation and attendance will be through Zoom only
 - PDF's on How to Make Public Comment at a meeting and How to Attend a Meeting through Zoom are posted on each meeting page on the website
 - Members of Council, Commissions, Boards and Committees may attend in person or via Zoom

NOTICE OF VACANCIES CITY COMMISSIONS, BOARDS & COMMITTEES

The City of Cannon Beach is seeking applications for the following vacancies:

TOURISM & ARTS COMMISSION: ONE (1) vacancy to fill four-year term immediately. The seven-member Tourism and Arts Commission develops grant guidelines and procedures and distributes and accounts for the monies in the "Tourism and Arts Fund" which are to be used by local non-profit groups to promote tourism and the arts in Cannon Beach. Each member shall have experience in one or more of the following areas: public relations, marketing, advertising, tourism, lodging, promotions, events promotion, art and/or publicity. The Tourism and Arts Commission holds its meetings as needed. **Note:** Tourism and Arts Commission applicants are not required to reside in Cannon Beach and are eligible if he or she has worked, at least part-time, within the City of Cannon Beach for at least one year, immediately preceding appointment.

PLANNING COMMISSION: TWO (2) vacancies to fill four-years terms, one beginning 1/1/22 and one beginning 2/1/22. The seven-member Planning Commission's primary responsibility is to review and consider land use matters and make determinations and recommendations regarding appropriate and orderly physical development of the City through the application of accepted standards and criteria. The Planning Commission holds its regular meeting on the fourth Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. and work sessions are scheduled monthly as needed.

DESIGN REVIEW BOARD: ONE (1) vacancy to fill four-year term beginning 1/1/22. The Design Review Board reviews development proposals that are subject to the design review provisions of the City's zoning ordinance. There are five members on the Design Review Board. The Design Review Board holds its regular meetings on the third Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. and may also schedule work sessions as needed.

BUDGET COMMITTEE: TWO (2) vacancies to fill three-year terms, one beginning immediately and one beginning 1/1/22. The Budget Committee fulfills an important need for citizen involvement in the City's budget process. The committee is involved in preparing the budget, and in helping to bring the budget to public awareness before it is adopted by Council prior to the end of the fiscal year (June 30). There are five members on the Budget Committee, and meeting times vary. **Note:** Budget Committee members must be a qualified voter of the district and must provide copy of voter registration card with application.

FARMERS MARKET COMMITTEE: ONE (1) vacancy to fill four-year term beginning 1/1/22. The Farmers Market Advisory Committee develops rules and procedures for the Market, monitor the Market finances and make recommendations to the Council on Market related matters. The Farmers Market Committee meets as needed.

- *FCC issued "FRN" registration number required BEFORE the class. Google "FRN" and register with the FCC to get your number.*

BE IN THE KNOW... We can't alert you if we can't reach YOU!

Community members and visitors can **CHOOSE UP TO 3** ways to receive emergency notifications and community information from Public Safety, City, Tribal and County Officials for Clatsop County, Oregon.

1. Residential and business landline numbers are automatically included in the emergency contact list and do not require any action.
2. Address specific numbers such as mobile numbers, mobile texts, e-mail, and fax numbers are not included in the emergency contact list and require a manual sign-up.

VACCINE INFORMATION

Clatsop County and its local partners are striving to ensure that local residents can receive the COVID-19 vaccine in as timely and convenient a manner as possible.

GROUPS CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE FOR VACCINATIONS: All individuals ages 12 and over

PLEASE NOTE: Currently the Pfizer vaccine is the only one approved for individuals under 18 and will be used for all individuals 12 to 17 years old who want to be vaccinated. Immediate family members of those 12 to 17 years old can also receive the Pfizer vaccine at the same events.

Other individuals age 18 and over who wish to be vaccinated will receive the Moderna vaccine.

If so, **the Haystack Rock Awareness can put them to good use in helping with our bird rescues.** We're in the midst of "jumpling" season, when young Murre chicks follow their fathers by jumping off Haystack Rock to fish in the waters below. Some of the chicks injure themselves, landing on rocks or sand. Others are washed ashore in strong swells and unable to get back out to sea.
