

Housing Commission Mission and Purpose

To collaboratively advocate for **attainable and equitable** solutions that impact Tillamook County's greatest housing needs.

To address workforce housing but also other areas of need for those who earn **up to 120% of County median income**.

Work to create a developer friendly environment and tools that will support developers in being financially successful.

- ➤ One non-voting liaison from the County Board of Commissioners
