The Cannon Beach City Council will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, December 5, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.** at Cannon Beach City Hall, 163 East Gower Street, Cannon Beach, should an appeal be filed regarding the following:

APP 23-07, Appeal of Design Review Board's denial of DRB 23-09, CIDA INC, applicant on behalf of the City of Cannon Beach for the rejuvenation project of the Cannon Beach Elementary School buildings and NeCus Park site for use by Cannon Beach visitors and residents, businesses, and the Clatsop Nehalem Confederated Tribe for a variety of community interests. The property is owned by the City of Cannon Beach and is located at 368 Beaver St (Tax Lot 04100, Map 51020CB) in a Institutional (IN) zone. The application will be reviewed against the criteria of Municipal Code, Chapter 17.44.080-17.44.100, Design Review Criteria.

The hearing will be held on the record and no new evidence will be allowed into record.
