NOTICE OF TREE REMOVED **IN THE STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY OR** **PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY**

The City of Cannon Beach has removed one red alder in the City right-of-way. The affected tree was located on Ecola Park Road, adjacent to a vacant lot, Map 51019AD, Tax Lot 10700.

The tree was removed based on Municipal Code Section 17.70.030 F, “if the condition of a tree presents an immediate danger of collapse and if such potential collapse represents a clear and present hazard to persons or property”. Municipal Code Section 17.70.030 I, Additional Requirements, states that for tree removal requests located in a street right-of-way, or on property owned by the city, property owners within one hundred feet of the tree(s) requested for removal shall be notified of the action. The notification shall also be posted on the city’s website, on the bulletin board at City Hall, and at the Post Office.
