WHEREAS, the city budgeted for improvements to upgrade the Siuslaw & Midway Pump Station in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 budget in the amount of \$220,000; and

WHEREAS, the bids received were greater than what was anticipated in the 2023-2024 budget; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid came in at \$465,700; and

WHEREAS, to fund the project cost of \$512,270 which includes an additional 10% for project costs, the use of budgeted contingency from the Wastewater Fund and the Wastewater Reserve fund will be required; and

WHEREAS, contingency of \$236,770 from the Wastewater Fund and contingency of \$55,500 from the Wastewater Reserve Fund will be used to add to the existing budgeted project cost of \$220,000. This will increase expenditures in the Wastewater Reserve fund in the amount of \$292,270; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cannon Beach hereby adopts the following FY 2023-2024 budget changes to the following funds.
