

- Hears traffic violations, city ordinance violations, and parking citations.
- Does not hear civil matters or small claims
- Is not a court of record
- Driving Under the Influence (DUI) cases, as well as major misdemeanor or felony cases, are referred to the Clatsop County District Attorney for prosecution in the Clatsop County Circuit Court
- Defendants appealing cases heard in the Municipal Court will have a new trial in the Clatsop County Circuit Court
- The Court is staffed by a presiding judge, a prosecuting attorney, public defenders (as applicable) and a municipal court clerk.
